In 2017 Candlelight Ranch launched Military Family days in partnership with the Hope Project. These monthly family days are open to veteran and military families with children and are FREE. Family Days are open to active-duty, veteran, gold-star, or other service-member families with children, with or without any and all disabilities.

Each month's event focuses on nature related themes and are held from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm. Daily activities include guided hikes, team building, low ropes, zip lines, canyon crawl, fishing, EAGALA/equine-assisted learning, and an opportunity for families to spend fun and therapeutic time together in nature.
