This year, we have exceeded our goal and served more special needs children, at-risk youth and their families than ever before -- over 2,400! The children and families that visited the Ranch experienced days filled with interactive and imaginative nature activities encircled by our accessible spaces. From the excitement of "flying" via a swift zip line, to bird watching, kayaking on Lake Travis and spying darting lizards on the nature trail, we spread so much joy at Candlelight Ranch.

In 2017, we expanded our services to include monthly military family days. We continued our Camp Dreamcatcher, designed for children who are currently in or have been adopted from Foster Care. We have strengthened our relationships with current partners including Camp Glimmer, the Phoenix Center/Camp Phoenix, Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired and Helping Hand Home for Children, just to name a few.
